Attendance since September with Reception is 95.67% and without Reception is 93.89% - this attendance percentage is well below the governmental standard and most of it is because of in term holidays.

The Governors are now going to look at fining families for in term holidays and I am supporting this decision because I don't see why the school should suffer because of in year holiday. 94% is not good enough and OFSTED would criticise the school heavily for this attendance.
