If you have a child, or know of anyone who has a child who was born between September 1st 2013 and 31st August 2014 then we are currently collecting applications for our Nursery.

At present we can offer 52 part time places, we can also assess pupils for eligibility for funded full time places and currently some parents pay for full time—although the Government is proposing changes to this but we haven't got all the information at present on the changes.

What I can tell you is that at St Cuthbert's Nursery there are fully trained teachers supporting your children with qualified teaching assistants and that the Governors and I believe that this offers your child the best start in education.

Prayer Garden

As you know we have a target to get the school prayer garden in place by the summer term and to that end we have two further fund raising activities to announce.

Monday 12th December will be Christmas Jumper Day—all children can wear their own clothes preferably with a Christmas jumper. If you don't have a Christmas jumper then a red or green top will be festive enough. As it is an extra non-uniform day we are asking for £1 per child and this money will all go towards the refurbishment of the courtyard.

On Friday January 20th we will be holding a school disco after school—I will give you more details on this later but obviously it will involve children changing into their own clothes and coming into the hall for a special school disco. Again any money raised will go towards the courtyard refurbishment.

At the moment we are looking at a date at the end of January to start clearing the courtyard in preparation for work to begin—I will confirm dates by next week and then we will be looking for volunteers to help us clear the courtyard.

Christmas Offerings

We had some charity money left over from our Lenten Fundraising activities and as a school we decided to make a donation to a couple of charities over this Christmas period.

We have given money to the NSPCC (National UK charity that support children) Save the Children (international charity who are helping children in countries affected by war) and Fireside (Homeless charity in Birmingham).

We felt that at this time of year it was important to try and help those who will not have a good Christmas and through your generosity we can do that.
